

Expansion and Compression Tanks – Part 10 Compression Tank and Expansion Tank Selection Examples

Today, let's look at a couple of selections and how the tank sizes and costs may vary based on location and type of tank selected. Our examples are shown in figures A & B. In each case we will use a system volume of 1500 gallons of water with a supply temperature of 200°F and 20°F Δ T. The system is 60 feet high and in each case the maximum pressure is 50 PSIG. **Example A Example B**


