Challenge


The new 85,000 square foot Gull Road Criminal Justice Facility (GRCJF) in Kalamazoo, MI, was completed in January 2016. The three-story building features courtrooms and court clerk, county prosecutor and FOC offices, as well as judge's chambers and holding rooms.
